Introduction:

Each year that passes on Cerro Nara, Costa Rica (Puntarenas, Costa Rica—Cerro Nara Region), abundant wildlife and endangered species live in the wildlife refuge, within the conservation lands of the protected zone of Cerro Nara mountain. The responsibility of wildlife protection has fallen to the four main property owners, which are encompassed by the Pro Nara Association, and projects implemented and managed by Team Cerro Nara, 501c.3 (California and Costa Rica) The landowners are group of dedicated conservationists, who have taken it upon themselves to regenerate the land for the past 30 years.

The landowners, who have registered their properties in the Zona Protectora de Cerro Nara, work continuously together to enforce the government's own law in their absence. There is almost zero direct protection from the authorities, who have mostly abandoned the pursuit to regulate and manage the poaching of the lands. They do not adequately prosecute the poachers. Because of this, these laws have historically been almost entirely enforced by local property owners in the Pro Nara association, who have afforded local caretaking, planting of trees, rehabilitation of land, and wildlife protection, all at their own cost.

Every day there is limited protection for the animals against the poachers, who move throughout the lands on secret trails killing animals for money and sport. While the finances of the property owners have afforded abundance, they have never been able to provide adequate protection via security cameras over the vastness of the land. In summary, the area can be observed better, studied, and protected with the use of cameras directed at animals and poaching activity.

Currently, a list of cameras and network infrastructure is ready to implement. We have identified equipment with our expert tech team, and ready to ship equipment onsite to Costa Rica. Volunteers, and landowners are onsite in Costa Rica to install the network and cameras within the rainforest. This will allow us to begin observation of both animals, and poachers on Cerro Nara Mountain; in an effort to spread awareness and better protect the environment. We have already hired the experts to set up the network, and manage forest cameras long-term from California, and onsite in Costa Rica.

Team Cerro Nara, 501c.3 (California USA and Costa Rica) works onsite in Costa Rica to manage onsite work, housing volunteers each month, and it's Board of Directors members are landowners and live part time in Costa Rica to oversee ongoing projects. This Camera Grant will allow our team to purchase and set up the infrastructure and a few test cameras, leading to a 2nd grant proposal to increase camera installations. The main purpose for this grant, is our constant effort to deter or catch poachers, and give this information to the Costa Rica authorities for prosecution of violators.

This Camera Grant includes the full cost of buying the equipment, shipping to Costa Rica, labor to set network up, volunteer support to install cameras in the forest, overhead costs associated with maintaining, and overhead costs.

We hope that you share our compassion for nature and wish to help this comprehensive project take shape in Costa Rica. The footage and results will be broadcasted on social media and vlogging networks such as YouTube, with a watermark indicating contributions from our donors. We will be using footage from the forest cameras, for inclusion in a documentary series, with in kind marketing opportunities for our donor organizations.
